FIRST STEPS

AFTER YOUR APPLICATION TO TU DELFT IS COMPLETE, YOU WILL RECEIVE EMAILS FROM TU DELFT AND TPM REGARDING THE INTRODUCTION!



INTRODUCTION PROGRAM ("IP")

- 2 days with a group of about 10 people from different nationalities (usually exchange students like you!)
- Discovery and visit of the campus + its different faculties and buildings (X TU Delft sports center, TU Library, and so on...)
- Lectures on different topics – in my case: "Life on TU Delft's campus", "The importance of feedback", "Interculturality" and "Introduction to Dutch Language"
- Introduction to TU Delft's associations (sports, communities, etc...)

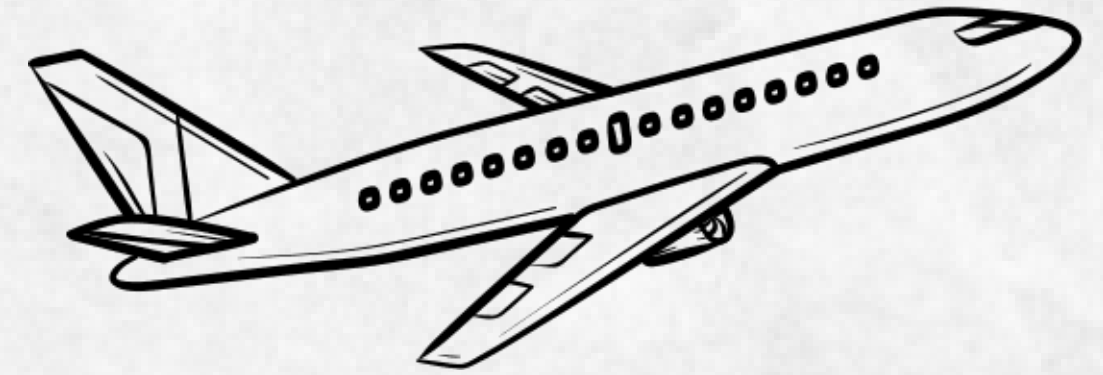
FACULTY INTRODUCTION

- varies per faculty and takes place after the IP
- Discovery of your faculty in details, in our case: **TPM – Technology, Policy and Management**
- Meeting with the international coordinator: **Charlotte Oosterom** + enrolment to your courses on Brightspace (if it's not already done)





SERVICES



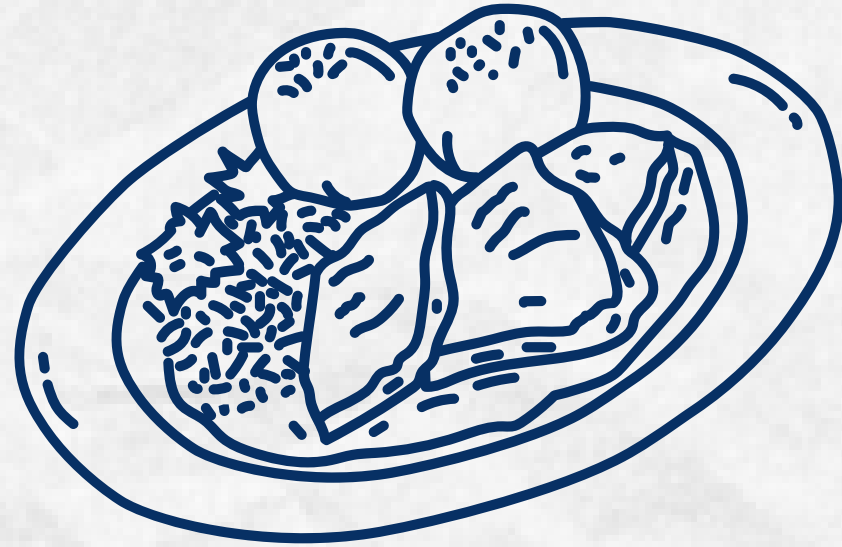
VERY Hard to find accomodation

- DUWO (300 subscription) and rent 300-1000 €
- I was at The Social Hub (hotel for only foreign students with a shared kitchen) but many students are in DUWO buildings
- Flat sharing but many without internationals or boys
- Lots of people taking the train everyday so do not only look for Delft accomodation but also in The Hague ...

Transport

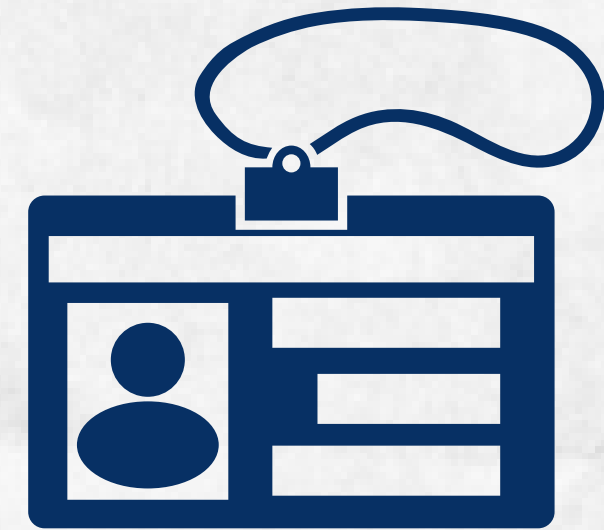
- 2 big airports
- Train : NS not SNCF : Very well served, create your NS card for paying lower prices
- Buy or rent a bike ! A must-have, all students have one
- Not many cars in the country, expensive parking city

SERVICES



Meals

- 2 supermarkets : Jumbo (cheaper) and Albert Heijn
- Sandwich or small lunch on the campus but no cafeteria like the RU
- A must-try : stroopwafel, herring, poffertjes
- Every Thursday and Sunday city-market with good product and food trucks, cheaper products at the end of the day (like 10 tulips for 2€)



Administration

- Depends on the TPM desk faculty
- Easy to reach by Phone or e-mail
- Grades from 1 to 10 with 6 to pass depending on the course
- Have to take a appointment to be a resident of the city of Delft. Have to deregister at the end too
- Normal to have to change courses because of overlapping timetables

STUDYING IN DELFT

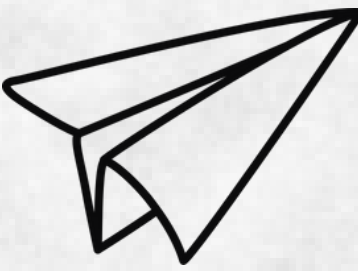
The courses are split in two quarters. At the end of each you have exams. It is also possible to have home assignment each week. Most of the time the courses do not have a lot of hours at the University, but it requires to work at home.

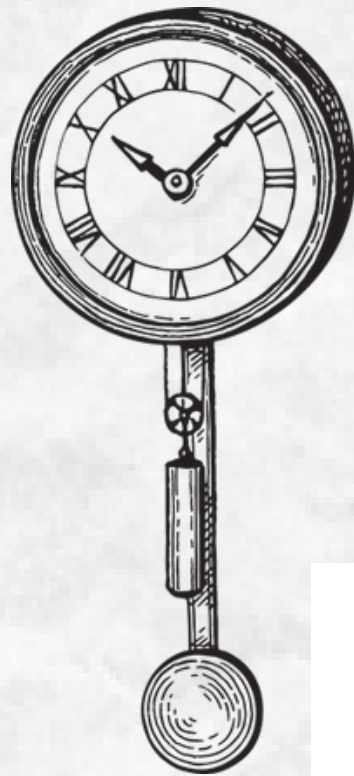
In order to follow a course, you have to subscribe first and then you can see it on the timetable. You can subscribe to a course, assist to the first lecture and if it does not fit you, you can delete it.

I recommend to go to as many first lecture as possible in order to make the best choice

THINGS TO KNOW



Security

There is no fear of aggression or pickpocket, people are really honest and respectful.

Everybody is on a bike. So at night the city is as sure as during the day. Watch out for cycle paths !

Appointment

Most Dutch students have a job on top of their studies, so it can be very difficult to fix a day for an appointment, so be prepared to work in groups without seeing them once. Watch out the clock, late is not usual.

Language

If you do not speak Dutch it is not an issue, most of the time people speak English even in the market or at the supermarket.

Dutch is not very spread so movies, studies are usually in english

TU DELFT APPS

Download "My TU Delft" app! It will allow you to see your calendar, consult your TU Delft email adress, see your grades, etc.

In addition, you will use a lot the website Brightspace! Every course you take has a folder where the teacher can put the lectures, the informations regarding the course, etc.

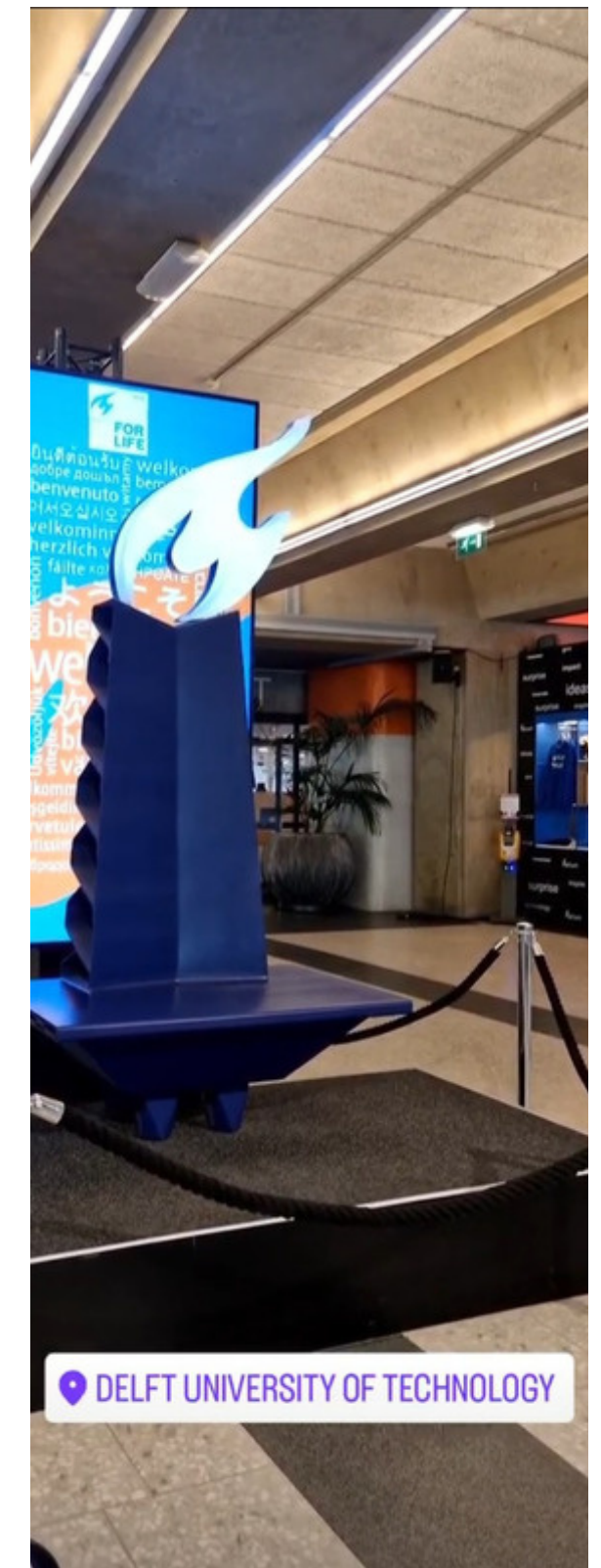
GOOD TO KNOW

- The international coordinator, Charlotte Oosterom is really nice! You can send her an email or go to her office in TPM whenever you have a problem regarding your courses or your student life in TU Delft!
- **PRINTERS** - there are a lot of printers available on the campus! You can use them thanks to your Student Card and the website "Print Portal TU Delft", where you can download the papers or documents you want to print
- **BIKES** - Be carefull because they have priority on the campus over pedestrians! And if you take your bike on the campus (and I advice you to do so) don't worry there are a lot of bike garages to store it!
- Don't worry if some of your courses overlap! You have two weeks after the beginning of the semester to change them!

GOOD TO KNOW

- **EXAMS** – you have to enroll to an exam to be allowed to take it. You can do that on My TU Delft app, but be careful: there is a **DEADLINE** to enroll for taking **ALL** the exams! **2 WEEKS BEFORE!** So be sure to sign up in advance otherwise you may not be able to attend an exam!
- As an exchange student from our school, the ENSGSI, you are considered as an MOT exchange student. MOT refers to the master Management of Technology, which is taught in TPM. However, you don't have to follow MOT courses! You can choose whatever you want in all the faculties, the only thing that is **MANDATORY** is, for you, to have at least 50% of your ECTS / credits in TPM faculty.



TECHNOLOGY, POLICY AND MANAGEMENT

- Our faculty is the smallest on the campus, but you will still find in it a lot of facilities. I recommend the cafeteria for meeting friends or your assignment group!
- The bike storage, situated behind the building is really huge. As a result, you will always find a place to park, even in the morning!
- In this faculty, you will – in theory – be able to find the courses you need in innovation engineering. For the rest, you can have a look in the seven other faculties of the TU Delft campus.

- THERE ARE A LOT OF SPORT ASSOCIATIONS, AND THEY TAKE PLACE AT THE SPORT CENTER OF THE UNIVERSITY: THE X CENTER!
- EVERY FACULTY HAS ITS "STUDY ASSOCIATION". IT IS LIKE A "BUREAU DES ELEVES" BUT FOR A FACULTY!
- IN TPM, THE STUDY ASSOCIATION IS CALLED CURIUS! ITS MEMBERS ARE REALLY NICE SO DON'T HESITATE TO GO TO CURIUS OFFICE IN TPM IF YOU HAVE AN ISSUE! (+ APPARENTLY IF YOU'RE LUCKY SOMETIMES YOU CAN GET A FREE COFFEE THERE)
- ON THE APP "UNI-LIFE", TU DELFT'S ASSOCIATIONS OFTEN POST THE ACTIVITIES/ EVENTS THEY ARE ORGANISING! TO ME, IT IS THEREFORE THE BEST WAY TO STAY INFORMED OF WHAT IS HAPPENING ON THE CAMPUS!

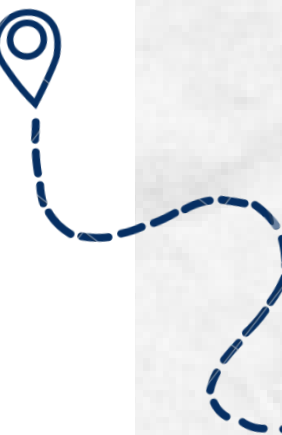
TPM'S TERRACE

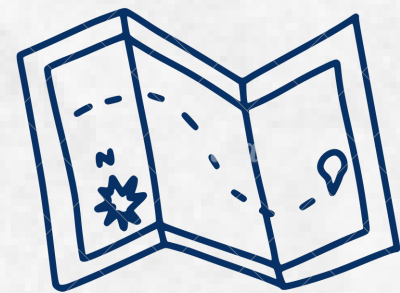
TU LIBRARY

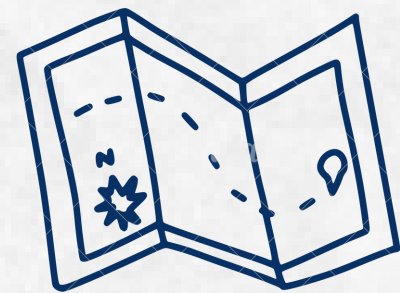

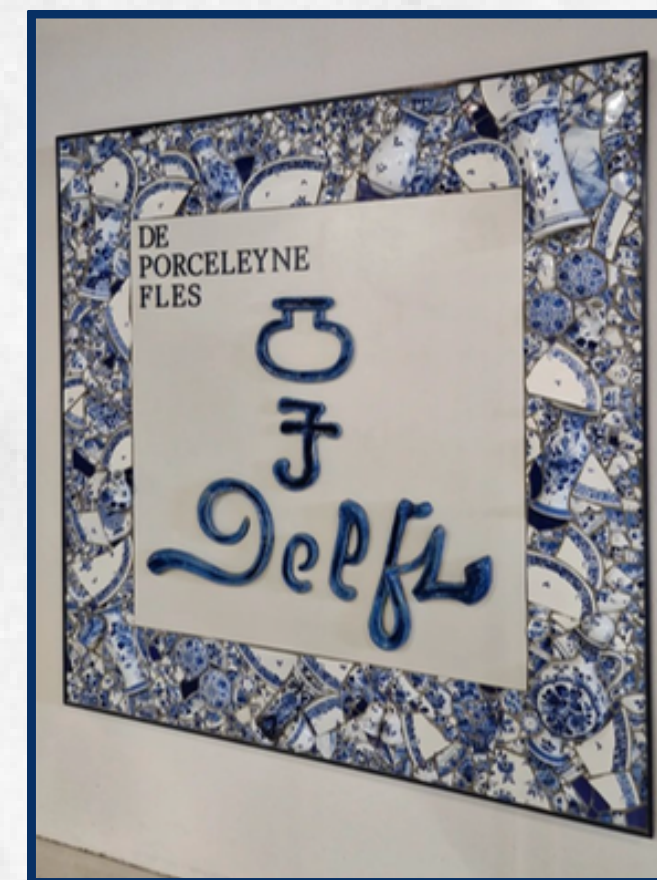


It is also possible to realise workshops at Royal Delft's factory! For example, I made my own tile by following the Royal Delft process to obtain a real Delft blue pottery!

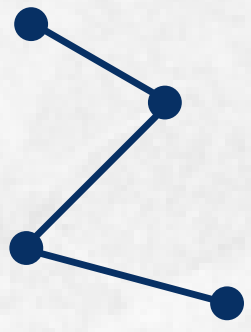

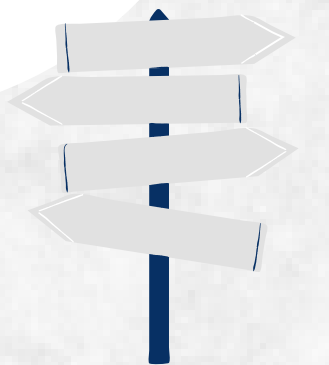

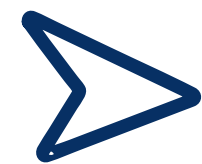


Harlem

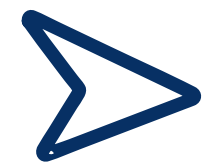

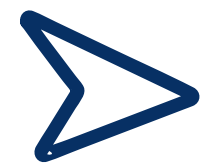
