Introduction

- Technische Hochschule Mannheim = University of Applied Sciences
- Located in Mannheim, Baden-Württemberg
- Around 5,500 students
- Strong focus on engineering, informatics, biotechnology, design, and social affairs



Practical information: Formalities



- **Enrollment:** done at the beginning of the semester with the International Office



- **Health insurance:** required for enrollment (European Health Insurance Card accepted)



- **City registration** (Anmeldung): must be done at the Bürgerdienste within 2 weeks



- **De-registration** (Abmeldung): required when leaving Germany

Practical information: Housing

- Managed by **Studierendenwerk Mannheim**
- Online application before arrival
- Monthly rent: ~**300–600 €**
- Options: single dorm rooms, shared flats, studios
- Private apartments possible but more expensive



Practical information: Daily life & budget



- Estimated monthly costs: **650–950 €**



- Food: **Mensa** meals around 4 €



- **Transport:** semester ticket optional; monthly ticket ~40 €



- **Erasmus** grant + other scholarships available

Academic life: The university

- Campus **near Mannheim city center**
- Libraries, modern labs, computer pools
- Sports and cultural activities available
- International Office offers support and welcome events



Academic life: Lectures & exams



- **Language:** most courses in English, some available in German



- **Teaching** = applied sciences: projects, labs, lectures



- **Exams:** written or oral depending on course



- Strict **rules** for exam registration and permitted materials
